(a) The Channel islands National Park Service (NPS) recently found out the Hikianalia, the sister ship of the Hokulea, will be visiting Ventura and then Channel Islands Harbor on Oct. 6th-10th. The plan for the arrival is on Saturday, Oct 6th around 2 pm. These ships are replicas of the original ships that brought the first Polynesians to Hawaii, using traditional navigational equipment and are therefore important part of the Hawaiian culture. Hokuloa OCC, the outrigger canoe club, will paddle out and meet them outside the harbor then escort them into the harbor. They will dock and then proceed to a welcome ceremony in the Ventura Harbor Village area. The NPS would like to get as many people, organizations and clubs from the community to join in. The NPS would like to provide a potluck around 4-5 pm for the crew and all involved in this event. Nothing definite at this time. (b) The Honolulu Little League Baseball Team won the World Series Championship by beating South Korea in August. A parade was held for the team and the members were recognized at the UH Football game played on September 8. (c) Hawaii is the happiest state in the nation, according to a ranking released by WalletHub. <u>California State Sport.</u> California's official state sport is SURFING. Gov. Jerry Brown on Aug 20 signed a bill which establishes surfing as California's state sport. Surfing is an iconic part of California's culture with around 1,100 miles of coastline. Out of curiosity I researched Hawaii's state sport and found that surfing was designated the state's official individual sport in 1998 and outrigger canoe paddling was adopted as Hawaii's official team sport in 1986. What state has the longest coast line? Answer: Alaska, followed by Florida, California, and Hawaii. What country has the longest coastline? Answer: Canada, followed by Indonesia, Greenland, and Russia.

Is Hawaii Business Friendly? Heck no! A recent survey by Thumbtack, an online service company that connects businesses with local professionals surveyed small business owners across the country asking questions in eight categories relating to business friendliness. The results help reveal why it is difficult to maintain an investment property that provides a consistent rate of return. Honolulu ranked 56th of 57 cities and the state of Hawaii ranked 49th of 50 states in terms of business friendliness. Both Honolulu and the state of Hawaii received letter grades of "F" for licensing requirements, tax regulations, ease of hiring, and government websites. Hawaii joined Illinois as the only two states to fail the survey of small business owners.
